## The University of Technology Sydney



UTS is a dynamic and innovative university in central Sydney. One of Australia's leading universities of technology, UTS has a distinct model of learning, strong research performance and a leading reputation for engagement with industry and the professions.

UTS is ranked in the top 250 universities by the Times Higher Education World University Rankings (opens an external site), which judges world class universities across all of their core missions — teaching, research, knowledge transfer and international outlook. UTS in 9th position is also the youngest of the 31 Australian universities included in the The World University Rankings top 800 rankings.

## Fees & Conditions

4-weeks program fee is \$40,000 + GST for 5 people.

The fee includes the following:

- Room and AV hire
- Academic Facilitation/ Lectures
- Campus Tour
- Industry Visits

- Light morning and afternoon tea
- Half day Sydney city tour
- Blue Mountain day tour

The fee does NOT include:

- Per diems (e.g. movies, room service, laundry)
- Flights
- Interpreter fee (an additional \$500 per day)
- Mobile simcards (\$22 per person)
- Opal Transport cards (\$20 per person)
- Lunches (\$20 per person per day)

### Options for Accommodation:

- Travelodge Hotel Sydney ( 2 twin + 1 single room) = \$507/ night x 28 days = AUD\$14,196.00
- Adina Apartment Hotel Sydney Central (2 bedroom apartment + 1 single) = \$466/ night x 28 days = AUD\$13,048.00

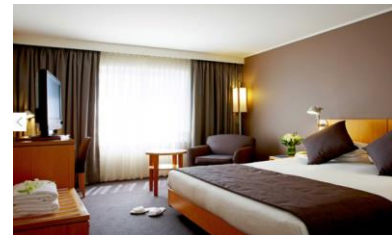

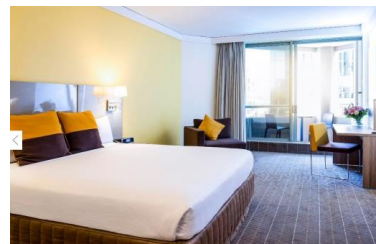
